

# CEAP Classification System and Reporting Standard

Clinical Manifestations | Etiology | Anatomic Distribution | Pathophysiology

<b>C0</b>	No visible or palpable signs of venous disease
<b>C1</b>	Telangiectasias or reticular veins
<b>C2</b>	Varicose veins
<b>C2r</b>	Recurrent varicose veins
<b>C3</b>	Edema
<b>C4</b>	Changes in skin and subcutaneous tissue secondary to chronic venous disease
<b>C4a</b>	Pigmentation or eczema
<b>C4b</b>	Lipodermatosclerosis or atrophie blanche
<b>C4c</b>	Corona phlebectatica
<b>C5</b>	Healed
<b>C6</b>	Active venous ulcer
<b>C6r</b>	Recurrent active venous ulcer
